Quality Area 4 Staffing Arrangements

POLICY STATEMENT

East Lismore Community Preschool is committed to ensuring the safety and well-being of all children at the Preschool. At all times, the Preschool will meet legislative requirements that requires a Nominated Supervisor or Responsible person to be physically present at all times the Preschool is caring for a child.

NATIONAL QUALITY STANDARDS

Organisation of Educators – The organisation of educators across the service supports children's learning and development

Management systems – Systems are in place to manage risk and enable the effective management and operation of a quality service

Element 7.1.3

Roles and responsibilities – Roles and responsibilities are clearly defined and understood and support effective decision- making and operation of the service.

AIMS

At all times a Responsible Person will be placed in day-to-day charge of the Preschool and this information will be documented and displayed. The responsible person may be the nominated supervisor or in their absence, a suitably qualified responsible person who meets the minimum requirements for a person in day-to-day charge.

IMPLEMENTATION – ROLE

The Nominated Supervisor or a responsible person must be physically present at the preschool at all times a child is being care for. A responsible person must have given their written consent to be placed in day-to-day charge of the service.

A person placed in day to day charge of the Preschool must meet the following requirements

- Thorough knowledge of the day-to-day responsibilities of being an educator at the service
- Be over 18 years of age

- Completion of an approved Child Protection Course
- A demonstrated understanding of
 - Educational & Care Services National Law Act 2010
 - o Education and Care Services National Regulations
 - Health and Safety including Child Protection responsibilities
 - The Preschool policies and procedures

For any person placed in charge of the day-to-day operation of the Preschool, consideration must be given as to whether the individual has been subject to compliance action or disciplinary proceedings under a children's services law, education law, or a previous education and care services law, in any state or territory.

IMPLEMENTATION - ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Approved Provider is responsible for

- Ensuring that the person placed in day to day charge of the preschool has met the requirements for this role
- Ensuring that there is always a person placed in day to day charge of the Preschool at all times that the Preschool is caring for a child. If the Nominated Supervisor is absent, then a responsible person is placed in day to day charge of the Preschool.
- Ensuring that the name of the Nominated Supervisor and Responsible Person in charge at the service is displayed and easily visible from the main entrance at the service.
- Notifying the Regulatory Authority in writing, if there is a change of person in the role of Nominated Supervisor
- Maintain appropriate records of the Nominated Supervisor and Responsible Persons consent to fulfil the role of nominated supervisor or responsible person accordingly
- Maintain appropriate records of the responsible person in attendance at all times that there are children being educated and cared for at the Preschool

The Nominated Supervisor is responsible for

- Providing written consent in accepting the role of Nominated Supervisor
- Ensuring that, in their absence, a responsible Person is placed in day to day charge of the Preschool
- Ensuring that the name and position of the person being placed in day to day charge of the Preschool is displayed and clearly visible from the entrance.

Early Childhood Teachers/Educators are responsible for

- Providing written consent in accepting the role of responsible person
- Check that the name and position of the responsible person in charge of the preschool is displayed and easily visible at the entrance to the Preschool
- Ensuring they have a sound understanding of the role of the Responsible person and Nominated supervisor and the difference between the roles.

Families are responsible for

• Being aware of the Responsible Person at the service
